REGIONAL ADMINISTRATOR'S REVISED ORDER

I hereby revise my *Order Reversing the Decision Issued by the National Appeals Office in This Matter*, dated June 6, 2012. In that Order, I concluded that Appellant is not eligible to receive a Pacific cod endorsement for the Western and Central Gulf on his License Limitation Program license (LLG 1721) with a catcher/processor designation. I further concluded that pursuant to 50 C.F.R. § 679.4(k)(3)(ii)(c), Appellant requested a change in the vessel designation on LLG 1721 from catcher/processor to catcher vessel, which would make Appellant eligible under 50 C.F.R. § 679.4(k)(10) to receive a Pacific cod endorsement for the Western and Central Gulf on LLG [REDACTED] with the catcher vessel designation.

However, based on recent communications from Appellant, it appears that Appellant no longer maintains his request to change the designation on LLG [REDACTED] from catcher/processor to catcher vessel. Therefore, I am revising my Order in pertinent part to state that Restricted Access Management (RAM), NOAA Fisheries, has authority to change the vessel designation on LLG [REDACTED] to catcher vessel *if Appellant maintains his request to do so*. Appellant may, if he wishes, maintain the catcher/processor designation on LLG [REDACTED], but without a Pacific cod endorsement for the Western and Central Gulf.

I remand this matter to RAM for further action consistent with this Revised Order.
