

ICCAT eBCD

Implementation Schedule

April 2013 – Government users training

May 2013 – Operational system; pilot testing in parallel with paper documents; paper still valid and entered into database by Secretariat

July 2013 – remaining issues discussed at IMM WG Meeting

September 2013 – non-government user training: “train the trainers”

November 2013 – revise/consolidate BCD/eBCD measures; user manual

March 2014 – fully operational; mandatory use (to be revisited at ICCAT)
