



## Atlantic Swordfish Landings Update 2007 Fishing Year

The table below provides preliminary landings estimates and remaining quotas as of June 30, 2007, in pounds (lb) and metric tons (mt) dressed weight (dw) for the Atlantic swordfish fisheries for the abbreviated 2007 fishing year. Please note that these estimates are subject to late reporting and do not include recreational landings or discards. Starting in 2008, the National Marine Fisheries Service will manage the Atlantic swordfish quota on a calendar year basis. Due to the switch to calendar years, 2007 is an abbreviated fishing year from June 1, 2007, through December 31, 2007. The 2007 annual directed landings quotas seen below have been adjusted for 2005 or 2006 underharvests. Commercial landings (not including discards and recreational landings) for the 2006 fishing season were 1,641.6 mt dw or 44.1 percent of the unadjusted 2006 fishing year quota.
