



**Change in Reporting Address and Contacts
 for NMFS Bluefin Tuna International Trade Program**

On January 1, 2012, the contact information and reporting address for our bluefin tuna international trade program changes to the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) National Seafood Inspection Laboratory (NSIL) in Pascagoula, MS. All import, export and re-export documents (i.e., bluefin tuna catch documents, re-export certificates, and biweekly reports with trade information) should be sent to the new address. However, please continue to send any biweekly reports that include U.S. domestic landings information to the NMFS Northeast Regional Office in Gloucester, MA, even if it also includes export data.
