Limited Entry Permit System

Keeps Hawai'i longline fishing small-scale.

International Agreements

Promote sustainable management abroad for 60% of the world's tuna.



Protections for Marine Life

Ensure that threatened and endangered species populations can recover.



Ecosystem-Based Approach

Uses science to understand and manage entire ocean ecosystems versus individual species.
