

Grants Enterprise Management System (GEMS)

 platform
- Scheduled to go live in October
- Recipients need to register in "eRA Commons."

IRA: Regional Fishery Management Councils - \$20M

FY23 Program Profile

- Initiate process for IRA specific grants to each Council
- Finalize priorities for projects in collaboration with Councils

Outyears (FY24-26) - \$20 million

- Execute IRA specific grants to each Council
- Execute project proposal process to determine funding amounts to each Council
- Support Councils in completion of identified projects and implementation of management measures




NMFS Budget Overview: FY 2024



Debt Ceiling Agreement Non-defense spending

- FY2024 will stay flat at FY 2023 levels
- FY 2025 allows for a 1% increase
- After 2025 growth caps replaced by appropriations targets
