<b>IRA Climate-Ready Fisheries Council Funding Priorities and Process</b>	Requested modifications to the <i>Template for Council RFA Proposals in FY24</i> . Track changes were provided to Ms. Denit from RMC directors and she will aim to incorporate those within the requested two week timeframe.
