
#### 2020-2023 BSAI Total Catch




#### 2023 BSAI Total Groundfish Catch by Gear & Sector




### 2023 A Season Bering Sea Pollock Directed Fishery (CV)




### 2023 A Season Bering Sea Pollock Directed Fishery (CP)








### 2023 Bering Sea Pollock Catch by Week and Sector




### 2023 Aleutian Islands Pollock Catch by Week and Sector




# 2023 Bering Sea Pollock ICA Catch by Week and Sector




#### 2019-2023 Trawl Catcher/Processor Incidental Catch of Pollock by Year and Target




### 2023 Pacific Cod Catch by Trawl Gear









#### 2019-2023 BSAI Trawl Catcher Vessel Pacific Cod Catch by Target




#### 2023 Aleutian Islands Pacific Cod Catch




### 2023 Pacific Cod Catch by Non-Trawl Gear




### 2023 Atka Mackerel Catch by Week and Area











### 2019-2023 Northern Rockfish Catch by Area






### 2023 BSAI Blackspotted / Rougheye Rockfish Catch








### 2023 BSAI Flatfish Catch by Amendment 80 Vessels







#### 2019-2023 BSAI Arrowtooth / Kamchatka Flounder Catch






### 2023 Skates Catch






# 2023 Zone 1 Trawl Red King Crab Incidental Catch by Target









# 2023 COBLZ Trawl Opilio Crab Incidental Catch by Target




# 2023 Zone 1 Trawl Bairdi Crab Incidental Catch by Target






### **BSAI Trawl Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch**








### 2023 BSAI Pollock Fishery Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch




# 2023 Non-Pollock Fishery Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch by Fishery and Sector










### 2023 Trawl Non-Chinook Salmon Incidental Catch
