Thank you for your letter requesting a federal fishery resource disaster determination pursuant to the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (MSA) for the Yurok Tribe's 2022 Klamath River Fall Chinook Run fishery. I am responding on behalf of the Secretary of Commerce to acknowledge receipt of your request and to inform you that the Fishery Resource Disasters Improvement Act, which was passed in the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023, has amended the MSA, and the Secretary is required to respond with her determination within 120 days after receipt of all the necessary data to conduct the analysis.

The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) conducts the evaluation needed for the Secretary's fishery disaster determinations. NMFS will work with the Yurok Tribe and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife to assess whether a fishery resource disaster has occurred under the MSA.

Based on our initial review of your request, previously provided information, and conversations with our West Coast Region Senior Policy Advisor, Frank Lockhart, we have the necessary information to assess whether a fishery resource disaster has occurred and consider your request complete.
