Kitty Hawk Wind applied for and received an Incidental Harassment Authorization (IHA: 86 FR 43212) under the Marine Mammal Protection Act to conduct marine site characterization surveys, specifically high-resolution geophysical (HRG) surveys, in federal and state waters of the coasts of North Carolina and Virginia, valid from August 1, 2022 to July 31, 2023.

This letter is to confirm that no HRG surveys occurred under this authorization. Should future HRG surveys need to be conducted for this project, a new IHA would be sought ahead of that time.
