Dear Ms. Harrison:

Park City Wind LLC applied for and received an Incidental Harassment Authorization (IHA; 87 FR 44087) under the Marine Mammal Protection Act to conduct marine site characterization surveys, specifically high-resolution geophysical (HRG) surveys, in federal and state waters of the coasts of Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, and New York valid from September 1, 2022 to August 31, 2023.

This letter is to confirm that no HRG surveys occurred under this authorization. Park City's IHA was renewed in December 2023 (88 FR 88892) to cover potential HRG surveys from March 1, 2024, through February 28, 2025. Park City will report on any HRG surveys conducted during this authorization term within 90 days of the completion of the surveys or expiration of the re-issued IHA, whichever comes sooner.
