



NMFS Budget Structure










Net Increase of \$20.5M in FY 2024 (ORF)

NMFS FY 2025 President's Budget Request

- \$1.2B total in discretionary accounts
- -\$56.1M below FY24 Enacted.
- Includes:
 - +\$17.9M inflationary costs (ATBs)
 - -\$74.0M (net) program changes

- Atlantic Bluefin Tuna (\$1.0M)
- Aquaculture Cooperative Institute (\$5M)
- ASMFC (\$10.0M)
